BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, That the preliminary budget for the 2021-2022 school year be adopted as the final budget in the CURRENT EXPENSE FUND 10 amount of \$2,314,282, SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 20 in the amount of \$25,328, and DEBT SERVICE FUND 40 in the amount of \$0.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that \$2,038,211 should be raised from local tax levy for the GENERAL FUND and \$0 should be raised for the DEBT SERVICE FUND for the 2021-2022 school year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenues for the 2021-2022 school year be adopted in the amounts of CURRENT EXPENSE FUND 10 in the amount of \$2,314,282, SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 20 in the amount of \$25,328 and DEBT SERVICE FUND 40 in the amount of \$0.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Superintendent and School Business Administrator are authorized to implement the approved budget in accordance with State laws and regulations and Board of Education policy and regulations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education adopts an equal twelve month tax collection schedule for distribution to the Boro of Beach Haven for the 2021-2022 school year.
