COVID-19 Update

The daily health screening is not needed prior to getting on the bus or entering the building. Rather, I remind you to check your child for COVID symptoms. Any child who is sick should not come to school. We ask you to report your child's daily absence to the school nurse.

Secondly, to ensure your child is not identified as a close contact with another student and needing to quarantine, we ask you to provide a mask for your child. While neck gaiters are permitted in school, the Department of Health, will not recognize neck gaiters as an acceptable face covering.
